

Gold	Understanding, respect, virtue, Majestic, generosity
White	Cleanliness, wisdom, innocence, peace, joy, sincerity
Red	Warrior or martyr; military strength, magnanimity, eagerness to serve his country
Blue	Steadfastness, strength, loyalty, truth
Green	Hope, joy, freedom, beauty, health
Orange	Worthy or rewarding ambition
Maroon	Victorious - Persevering or patient in the battle
Black	Constancy, grief, resistance
Purple	Royal majesty, sovereignty, justice
